

HOW TO USE GOOGLE CLASSROOM FOR PARENTS & STUDENTS

Google Classroom is a web-based learning environment. When logged into Google Classroom, students can collaborate with their peers and teachers. Google Classroom offers a digital safe space for students to view class announcements, access posted course content, view posted assignments, and turn in completed work.

1. From any computer with internet access, click this link <https://classroom.google.com> and have the student login with their Gmail username and password. Please note that any activity in Google Classroom is documented under the student's login.
2. As a guardian, you must receive and accept an email invitation from a teacher for Google Classroom access. Guardian alert emails include:
 - o Missing work—Work that's late at the time the email was sent
 - o Upcoming work—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or work that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails)
 - o Class activity—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers

Join a Class

In the upper right click on the plus button to join a class. Enter the class code.

Stream

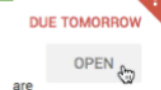
Find your assignment in the Stream.

Click the blue Turn In or Mark As Done button.
